Choose quality ingredients, reduce waste and carbon footprint, and support the local economy

- Utilize reusable artificial plants, vegetables, fruits, and flowers
- Provide drinking water service points instead of individual servings
- Use glass instead of plastic bottles, or set up common water service points
- Food menus prepared with plant-based ingredients or whole grains
- Use ingredients from the local community, including seasonal fruits and vegetables
- Select vendors and service providers that support sustainable operations
- Reduce the use of one-time-use packaging by using environmentally friendly containers
- Set up signs to promote sustainable events
- Demonstrate clear intentions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from transportation

- Use standard energy-saving electrical equipment
- Utilize renewable energy sources, such as solar energy



Waste Management

Follow the correct and proper procedures

- Separate food and beverage waste so it can be repurposed or disposed of efficiently, such as by making fertilizer to improve soil quality
- Encourage customers to take leftover food home or donate it to those in need within the community
